

HAWAII WEAPONS REGISTRATION

HAWAII REV. STATE 134-3, REQUIRES THAT ANY FIREARM BROUGHT INTO THE STATE OF HAWAII SHALL BE REGISTERED WITH LOCAL POLICE WITHIN THREE DAYS AFTER ARRIVAL OF THE PERSON OR OF THE FIREARM, WHICHEVER ARRIVES LATER.

In discussions with the local Police Weapons Clerk in Hilo, I have been informed that they will work with the Hawaii PITA and competitors to make this one time registration as easy as possible. Individuals registering their shotguns will be required to provide personal data for a background check and each weapon imported to verify serial #, barrel length, make, gauge and model.

The Weapons Registration Clerk has provided the HPITA with a blank application form for firearms importation. This form should be filled out by the individual **DO NOT SIGN THIS FORM (signing the form has be done in front of a Hawaii official)** and mailed to ROBERT ROLLER, 79-5254 KUU IPO PL, KEALAKEKUA HI 96750, 808-322-7815 email captbob@konacharters.com. Mailing should be done prior to January ,2009 .

The Hawaii PITA has the responsibility to inform all competitors, Hawaiian residents, non-Hawaiian residents or non-United States citizens what the law of the land is. Compliance is then a mater of personal responsibility.
