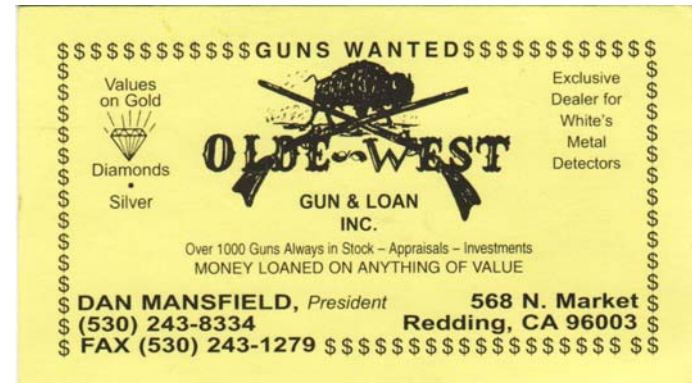

Juniors can shoot this program for \$20 + daily & Ev. fees but no options can be played.

Saturday and Sunday the clubhouse will open at 8:00. Lunch will be available each day from 11.00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.

The practice trap will open each day at 8:30 a.m. Popular brands of shells are available.

The club has a limited number of R.V. hookups on a first come basis and there is a lot of parking for self-contained units. If you use electricity there is a \$10.00 per day fee for its use.
